1. To be held September 11-17, 2011 in Reggio Emilia, Italy.
2. For four, five, six and seven-year-old horses – Open to all breeds – Entry must be named and licensed at the time of entry. See the current *NRHA Handbook* for information on how the age of a horse is determined.
3. Owners and riders must be current NRHA members.
1. 4. **PAYMENT OF FEES:** Complete payment information will be included on the entry form. It is the owner's responsibility to make the entry on or before the due date. Show Management will not be responsible for entries not received by the due date or lost in the mail. An entry check returned due to insufficient funds will constitute an incomplete entry. Failure to pay applies to the rider, owner, or agent for any unpaid debts, related to the entry, exhibition, showing, stalling, or any related fee of an entry at an approved NRHA event. Agent is defined as anyone who acts and/or signs on the behalf of an owner or rider (see General Rules and Regulations, F. Failure to pay in the current *NRHA Handbook*).
5. **TRANSFERS BETWEEN DERBIES:** An entry may transfer from the Open to Non Pro Derby by paying a 25€ penalty. All entry payments will be applied to Non Pro entry fees and refunds will be granted. If the entry is transferred after 8 August 2011 but by 5:00 p.m. two days prior to the go round, the entry will be within a group to run prior to the regularly drawn horses in the order they are received.

An entry may transfer from the Non Pro to the Open Derby by paying a 25€ penalty. All entry payments will be applied to Open entry fees and any additional fees owed must be paid to

compete. If the entry is transferred after August 8 but by 5:00 p.m. two days prior to the go round, the entry will be within a group to run prior to the regularly drawn horses in the order they are received.

The deadline to transfer between derbies is 5:00 p.m. two days prior to the first go round.

6. **SCRATCHES**: The show secretary must be notified if an entry will be scratched. If the scratched entry has a balance due, that amount must still be paid. Do not at any time stop payment of entry fees or late fees with your financial institution.
7. **REFUNDS**: There will be no refunds for horses entered but dropped or scratched for any reason. If any entry payment is paid in advance, the payment is non-refundable after NRHA processes the payment.
8. **The show retainage** for the Derby will be 50%, in addition to the standard 5% NRHA show fee deduction.
9. **NRHA COMPETITION LICENSE**: All horses competing in NRHA approved competition will be required to have a competition license. A completed competition license application must accompany the entry if not previously applied for. A photocopy of breed registration papers must accompany application for registered horses. For non-registered horses, color photographs showing full left and right sides and full front and back views, specifically showing all marks of identification, must be submitted with the application. Owners are required to be members of NRHA prior to completing the license process.
10. **SUBSTITUTION / TRANSFER OF ENTRY**: There will be no substitutions of horses/entries for any reason.
11. **CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP**: An entered horse may change ownership and retain entry status under the new owner provided that the transfer of the NRHA Competition License is complete and the new owner is a member of the National Reining Horse Association.
12. **PAYEE**: Prize money will be paid to the owner as recorded in the NRHA database at the start of the event or designated agent. Taxes may be deducted as national laws dictate. If the horse is transferred during the show, the previous owner and the new owner must complete an Authorization of Prize Money Payment Form.
13. Owners may enter more than one horse. A horse may be entered only once per Derby (Open or Non Pro). Riders may ride no more than three horses per Derby.
14. **RIDERS**: Rider designation coupons must be received no later than 8 August 2011 (**POSTMARKS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED**). If the Rider Designation coupon is not received by 8 August 2011, the rider will be indicated as "Rider Not Designated" and NRHA is not responsible for draw positions closer than the conditions specify. In the Open draw, NRHA will attempt to separate horses with a common rider by at least twenty (20) horses or highest number possible. In the Non Pro draw, NRHA will attempt to separate horses with a common rider or owner by at least twenty (20) horses or highest number possible.

15. **JUDGES:** All decisions of the judges are final. There will be five judges placed at different points in the arena for the Derby; the high score and low score will be eliminated with only the total of the remaining three (3) scores used to determine the final score. A pre-check will be utilized.
16. **JUDGES FEES:** The Judges fee of 100€/50€ is due at the time entry is made.
17. **CLASSES** will be operated in accordance with NRHA rules. The NRHA Officers and Board of Directors reserve the right to interpret these rules and regulations. All decisions will be final. By way of making an entry, the exhibitor is assuming responsibility for knowledge of NRHA rules and releases NRHA and its officers, directors, employees and Show management from any claims or losses.
18. **TIES:** In the event of a tie in the Derby finals, the tie breaking procedures as outlined in the current year *NRHA Handbook* will be used to break the tie.
19. **RULE CHANGES:** The NRHA Executive Board reserves the right to modify or change conditions for the NRHA European Derby.
20. **RIGHT TO CANCEL:** The NRHA reserves the right to cancel this event without notice at any time prior to the show without liability, but in such event will return all entry money to the subscribers. Interest earned on the entries is the property of the National Reining Horse Association.

Entries are received subject to the right of the NRHA Executive Board to refuse the entry without notice to the subscriber. Acceptance of the entry is based on the representations made on the entry form. Decisions of the Executive Committee will be final.

Riders are responsible to know and adhere to eligibility requirements for NRHA events. A rider who enters an event or division in which he/she is ineligible, will forfeit all winnings and entry fees to the NRHA, and be subject to disciplinary action by the NRHA Board of Directors for unsportsmanlike conduct as set forth in the *NRHA Handbook*. The rider is responsible for the entry information regardless of whether the form is completed by the agent or owner.

21. Show management reserves the right to discipline any person that it concludes has abused or permitted abusive behavior against a horse, or engaged in unsportsmanlike conduct toward show management, judges or exhibitors. Discipline may include official warning, elimination from competition or any other action deemed appropriate by the show management

1. All Derby Event conditions 1 through 21 shall apply.
2. The entry fee of 500€ is payable in 1 payment on or before 25 July 2011
3. LATE ENTRIES: If the entry is not made on or before 25 July 2011, the following late fees will apply:

4. Entry into the Level 3 Open division will be automatic based upon rider eligibility. Please see the current NRHA Handbook for eligibility requirements. For members giving up Non Pro cards please refer to the Non Pro conditions in the current NRHA Handbook.
5. **LEVEL 4 OPEN DIVISION**: The Level 4 Open purse will have \$31,000 added. Of the 500€ entry fee, 200€ will be deducted for the Level 3 Open purse for each Level 3 eligible entry. The entry fees less the 50% show retainage fee and the standard 5% show fee deduction, will be added back; with 5% going to the first go round and 95% to the finals. The Level 4 Open Division will consist of one go round, a consolation round and a finals. The top 20 horses plus ties from the go round will automatically advance to the finals. In addition, the top 5 entries plus ties from the Consolation class will advance to the Level 4 Open division finals (See Consolation class conditions for full details.). The winner will be determined by the finals score.
6. **LEVEL 3 OPEN DIVISION** purse will have \$30,000 added plus a 200€ division allocation for each Level 3 Open eligible entry less the 50% show retainage fee and the standard 5% show fee deduction; with 5% going to the go round and 95% to the finals. The Level 3 Open division will consist of one go round and a finals. The top 20 horses plus ties from the go round will automatically advance to the finals. The winner will be determined by the finals score.
7. The go round will use the following NRHA Handbook Payback Schedule B percentages.
8. The finals will be a clean slate format.
9. All horses that advance to finals will receive a paycheck (exception: No Scores).

10. **LEVEL 4 OPEN DIVISION FINALS:** There will be twenty-five places plus ties paid using the following percentages and guaranteed monies:

1. All Derby Event Conditions 1 through 21 shall apply.
2. The Level 2 Open entry fee of 300€ + 50€ judges fee is payable in one payment due on or before 25 July 2011.
3. Late entries received 26 July 2011 through two days prior to the first go round will be charged a 75€ late fee. There will be no entries accepted after 5:00 pm two days prior to the first go round.
4. Late entries received after 8 August 2011 will be considered post entries and will be included in a group preceding the regular draw order. This post-entered group will be positioned in order of receipt with the last entry going first.
5. Entry into the Level 1 Open division will be automatic based upon rider eligibility. Please see the current NRHA Handbook for eligibility requirements. For members giving up Non Pro cards please refer to the Non Pro conditions in the current NRHA Handbook.

The Level 1 Open division will consist of one go round and a finals. The top 20 horses plus ties will automatically advance to the finals. The winner will be determined by the finals score.

2. The Top 20 scoring entries plus ties in the Level 4 Open Division go round advance to the Level 4 Open finals. The next 20 scoring entries plus ties in the Level 4 Open Division go round may enter the Consolation class. The Top 5 scoring entries plus ties will qualify for the Level 4 Open finals.
3. Any eligible entry wishing to enter the Consolation Class must declare their intent to do so by noon the day before the class is to run.
4. There is no Open Consolation class purse or entry fee.
5. The Consolation class is a clean-slate format.
6. No schooling in the Consolation Class is permitted.
7. The top five scoring entries plus ties from the Consolation Class will advance to the Level 4 Open Division finals.

2. Non Pro entries must qualify under the Non Pro definition and Non Pro ownership definition as stated in the current NRHA Handbook. All riders are responsible to know and adhere to eligibility requirements for NRHA events. Acceptance of the entry by the show secretary is based upon the representation made on the entry form regardless of who completes said form.
3. The Top 15 scoring entries plus ties in the Level 4 Non Pro Division go round advance to the Non Pro finals. The next 15 scoring entries plus ties in the Level 4 Non Pro Division go round may enter the Consolation Class. The Top 5 scoring entries plus ties will qualify for the Level 4 Non Pro finals.
4. Any eligible entry wishing to enter the Consolation Class must declare their intent to do so by noon the day before the class is to run.
5. There is no Non Pro Consolation class purse or entry fee.
6. No schooling in the Consolation Class is permitted.
7. The top five scoring entries plus ties from the Consolation Class will advance to the Level 4 Non Pro Division finals.
